







Total Weekday Bus Ridership


of Riders Per Service Hour vs. Average Weekday Passengers

of Riders Per Service Hour (RPSH) vs. Average Weeknight Passengers



Weekend Ridership


of Riders Per Service Hour vs. Average Weekend Passengers






Streetcar Ridership




