PROJECT OVERVIEW

The OKC Moves Proposed Service Changes are based on recommendations from the year-long OKC Moves Bus Study, which was conducted by nationally-recognized transit firm Nelson\Nygaard and accepted by the Central Oklahoma Transportation and Parking Authority (COTPA) Board in March 2022.

The OKC Moves Proposed Service Changes aim to:

- improve on-time performance and efficiency of bus service
- extend service into some new areas,
- integrate Oklahoma City's first Bus Rapid Transit line RAPID NW - into the transit system.

All EMBARK bus routes in Oklahoma City will have some schedule adjustments, and several routes will see significant changes. These proposed changes will also affect all EMBARK Plus zones for individuals who are functionally unable to use fixed-route bus services.

FARE UPDATES

There are no proposed changes to bus fares.
